Camp For All – Our YMCA understands everyone has different abilities to pay for camp events. We are committed to making Hi–Rock programs available to all. We have adopted a 4-tier pricing program for the reunion. Please consider the tier descriptions below and choose the tier that is most suitable for you. No proof of financial need is required for tiers 1 – 3. Your selection is confidential and will not affect your experience at camp in any way.

Tier 1 - Most accurately reflects the true cost of camp events including, but not limited to, general overhead, equipment and facility maintenance, capital improvements and staffing.
