Thanks to the generosity of many members of the YMCA Camp Hi-Rock community and the hard work of our volunteers, we just took a big step toward rebuilding Parker Seeley Lodge! We have begun the deconstruction to make way for a NEW lodge (incorporating the old chimney!). The new lodge will take its place, once again, as the main lodge and the hub of all camp activity. This step marks the beginning of one of the key projects being undertaken through the Campaign for YMCA Camp Hi-Rock which seeks to raise \$2.8 million to address critical needs at camp. Other goals of the campaign include rebuilding several camper cabins, resurfacing the ball fields, rebuilding shower houses, and repairing staff housing including the Wheel House. Early accomplishments of the campaign included the construction of stone retaining walls on the dining hall hill and installation of drainage on the main ball field.

We want to send a big Hi-Rock style thank you to all who have made this possible. If you have not yet made a commitment to the Campaign for Hi-Rock, please consider doing so this summer to help make it possible to begin building the new lodge this fall. NEW PROGRAMS FOR SUMMER 2013

GEOCACHING – A 21ST CENTURY TREASURE HUNT

CAMP EDIBLE GARDEN

Throughout the summer of 2013, some Hi-Rock campers will have the opportunity to grow their own food. Don't worry – we will continue to provide three meals a day! Lauren Deutsch, a long time camper who is working as an intern from Hampshire College this summer, will supervise the garden. Campers will cultivate the plants, learn about sustainable farming, and eat the fruits of their labor. Some of the "crops" they will work with include basil, cilantro, potatoes, lettuce, and more.

CAMP MENTORS

Camp is a place for kids to grow – we all know this to be true. One of the most important factors in a child's development is to have strong positive role models. At Hi-Rock, we have worked hard to provide the best counselors and staff members possible, but Abnakis and Woodlands also look up

to the Mohawk and Algonquin campers. Each session in 2013, the oldest units will work with the youngest units to foster friendships and provide camp mentors.



FOR THE LOVE OF CAMP

About ten years ago, Ian Ruiz Carlile attended Camp Hi-Rock for the first time as a camper. He was fifteen years old and had been to several other camps before but it was not until he got to Hi-Rock that he found his home away from home. He fell in love with the way of life at Hi-Rock – the deeply caring atmosphere, the celebration of silliness, and the diversity of the people. He loved the way camp took him out of what he described as "his bubble" – his life in New York City – and introduced him to a whole new world of friends and perspectives.

A few years later Ian became a counselor and learned during staff training about the Strong Kids Campaign. When asked to recount what happened that summer, he describes how he felt compelled to make a contribution and resolved to do so. He was not yet at the point in his life where he had opened his own checking account so every two weeks on payday he hitched a ride to the local bank to cash his paycheck and the following day would quietly find his way to the camp director and hand her some folded bills. This ritual went on all summer with lan contributing \$100 every two weeks throughout the eight week summer. Those of you familiar with camp counselor wages will understand that this was no small sacrifice!

In the years that have passed since lan first became a donor to the campaign, he has continued to contribute significantly to the campaign each year and says he will always do so, no matter where he is in life. Ian explains that as a camper, 'Camp was such a big part of my life and was very giving to me. While there, I found out who I was and everything I could be. I felt like I had an obligation to give back to the camp which went beyond just working there."

He feels it is important for all children to have access to camp, especially urban youth who rarely have the opportunity to venture out of the city. Ian fondly remembers a camper named Yarrell who grew up in a city. When Yarrell came to Hi-Rock he was fascinated with the frogs he found around camp – the first frogs he had ever seen in real life! He was thrilled by the frogs and ran around camp showing everyone

a frog he had picked up. Ian feels this kind of thing is so important. "Youth in the city would never have an opportunity like that – to catch a frog!"

lan has several causes that he supports but Hi-Rock will always be the one to which he feels the most compelled to give. When asked how it felt, that first summer, to make such a generous contribution, he responded, "It felt good but that's not why I did it. It was the right thing to do." Then he added, "I will bring my checkbook this summer to make things easier."

work began with a grueling effort to clean up down trees and debris left by Hurricane Sandy last fall. MAKING THE OLD NEW AGAIN


